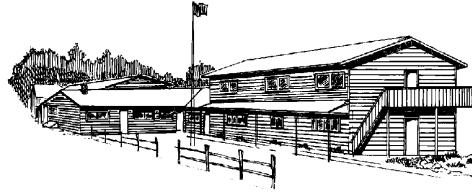


Comments from Previous Retreats

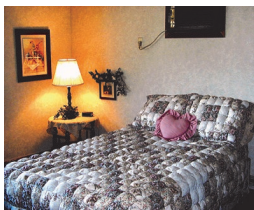
