Frequently Asked Questions:

What will I do?

COUNSELORS: Counselors will usually have 10 or fewer campers in their cabin. They are responsible for those campers the entire time they are at camp. Counselors attend all services, games, and have responsibilities during recreation time so that they are with the campers. During teen weeks, counselors may officiate some sport games and may have opportunities to play in some.

OPERATIONAL STAFF: Operational staff includes housekeeping, grounds crew, waitress, lifeguard, nurse, assistant cook, dishwasher, security, etc., and are the work force that keeps and maintains the facilities and serves the campers.

When does Camp start and finish?

Summer starts with Training Camp during the last week in May and ends after the first or second week in August. If you can't stay for all of the summer, it is still possible that we could use you; however, we prefer that staff stay for the entire camping season. We do give preference to those who are able to stay.

Will I have any time off during the week?

Summer staff is "off" once clean-up is finished (approximately 2 PM, Saturday) until the staff meeting at the beginning of the following camp week (Sunday afternoon or Monday morning). If you need a whole week off during the summer, we try to schedule a week off for each team member, if necessary. Of course, not everyone can have the same week off; so, if you have a particular week in mind, let Camp Joy know as soon as possible.

How much training do I need?

We have a week-long training program which includes instruction in the philosophy of camping, counseling, discipline and the age characteristics of each group. These sessions are designed to teach the counselor how to deal with the frustrations he or she will encounter during the summer and how to address the spiritual problems that their campers will have. We provide materials for counselors to read to help prepare them for their summer ministry prior to their arrival at camp.

Is this a paid position?

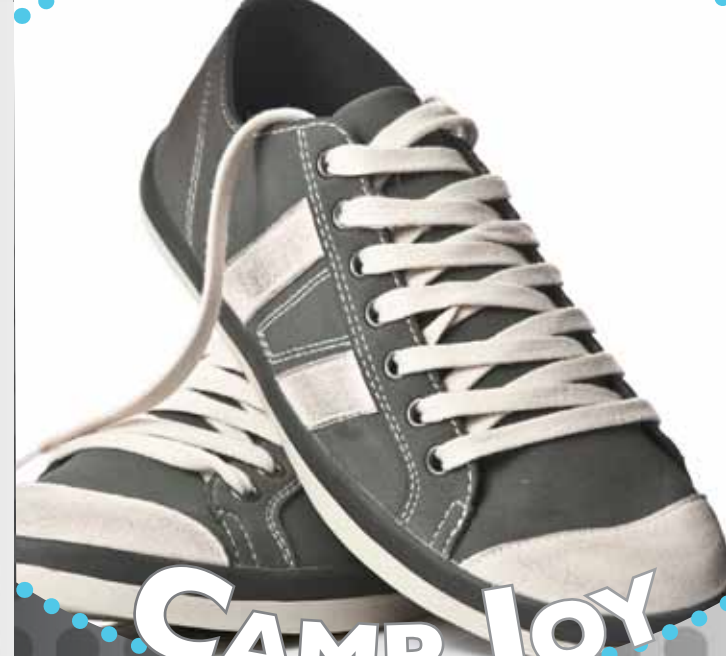
Each Summer Ministry Team Member will be given tools in order to help them raise their own support.
